PROFESSOR TREVOR BURKE, DDS, BDS, MSc, MDS, FDS, MGDS RCS (Ed), FDS RCPS (Glas), FDS RCS (Eng), FFGDP (UK), FADM

Trevor Burke graduated at Queens University Belfast, and, following appointments in Belfast and Manchester, he worked in general dental practice from 1975 to 1996 in Manchester, also working 1.5 days per week in the Unit of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Manchester. He moved to his present position as Professor of Primary Dental Care at the University of Birmingham and Hon. Consultant in Restorative Dentistry in 2000.

Trevor is (co-) author of 290 papers published in peer-reviewed journals and three books. His principal interests are in the translation of in vitro research on dental materials into the clinical situation. In this regard, he co-ordinates the work of two practice-based research groups (The PREP Panel, with 33 dentists UK-wide and BRIDGE, a West Midlands group with 18 dentists) who carry out clinical evaluations of a variety of materials. He is Chair of the Practice-based Research Network of the IADR. Trevor has been Programme Director of a Masters course in Advanced General Dental Practice for 13 years, this being part time to suit the busy lives of dental practitioners. A Distance version of the course commenced in Feb.2013. Trevor is also Editorial Director of Dental Update and is Chair of the Board of Dental Protection.

DR. EVA ORSMOND

Dr. Eva Orsmond is a medical doctor from Finland who came to live in Ireland approximately 12 years ago. She founded Orsmond Clinics in 2001, to pursue her interest in weight loss and nutrition and is now a leading expert in her field.

A regular contributor to professional publications, Dr. Orsmond also engages with the public to promote understanding of the consequences of overweight, appearing on a number of television and radio programmes, including, Prime Time, The Saturday Night Show, The Late Late Show, Off the Rails, Exposé, The Afternoon Show, The Marian Finucane Show, The Ray d'Arcy Show and The Mooney Show. She is probably best known in the role as the diet and nutrition expert on RTE's hugely popular Operation Transformation which she held for six years.

Dr. Eva's first book "The Last Diet" was published and launched in January 2011 and her second book "10LB Diet" was released in December 2013. Both books are available in leading bookshops.

Dr. Eva currently has a number of clinics nationwide. She has a clinic in Oranmore, Co. Galway, two clinics in Dublin, one in Loughlinstown, Dublin 18 and one in Baggot Street in the city centre and her latest clinic opened earlier this year in Kilkenny.

Considered a leading expert in her field, Dr. Eva remains Ireland's sole private Medical Practitioner exclusively treating overweight and obesity in adults and children.
