This half-day hands-on course is aimed at general dental practitioners and those with a particular interest in endodontics.

Following this course clinicians should be able to:

- 1) assess teeth for endodontic treatment and make an accurate diagnosis, determine suitability for treatment and estimate difficulty in treating successfully.
- 2) organise themselves so that if and when endodontic treatment is required an appropriate instrument set-up is present to enable treatment to proceed in an orderly fashion.
- 3) design appropriate access cavity preparations to enable treatment but minimise tooth weakening.
- 4) prepare and disinfect root canals to minimise post-treatment infections and facilitate obturation.

Pat graduated from Trinity College Dublin in 1981 with a BDentSc. Following a term as House Surgeon in the Dublin Dental Hospital, he practised in Portlaoise and then in England. He undertook postgraduate studies at Indiana University School of Dentistry from 1984 to 1986 and was awarded a certificate and masters degree in endodontics. On returning to Ireland in 1986 he set up his practice limited to endodontics in Booterstown, which he maintains to the present day. He was President of the IDA in 2003 and has presented at numerous meetings in Ireland and Europe.
