SPEAKERS MORNING

Dr Micheál Healy



Micheál operates a practice limited to prosthodontics at the Kingdom Clinic, Killarney. He gained his BDS at University College Cork (UCC) before embarking on his specialist training at Guy's Hospital, London. He completed his Master's of Clinical Dentistry in Prosthodontics at

King's College London (KCL), followed by his Membership in prosthodontics at the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. He has taught undergraduate students in Ireland at UCC and in the UK at KCL.

Dr Niamh McAuliffe



Niamh graduated with honours from UCC in 2001. She completed a year of vocational training in Ireland, followed by two years as a senior house officer in Wales. In 2003, she completed her Membership of the Faculty of Dental Surgery examinations with the Royal College of Surgeons of England. She

undertook orthodontic specialist training at Liverpool University Dental Hospital and Halton General Hospital, and attained her Membership in orthodontics with the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh in 2007.

Dr Aisling O'Sullivan



Aisling graduated from UCC in 2019. She undertook the MFDS examination in RCSI in 2020 and graduated with a Master's in Dental Public Health (MDPH) from the CUDSH in 2021. Her MDPH research dissertation focused on the burden of head and neck cancer in Europe. The

results of her research have been published internationally. She continues to work in general practice in Kerry, while also working part-time as a clinical tutor in the restorative and paediatric departments in CUDSH.

Dr Claire Curtin



Claire graduated from UCC in 2007, and after spending several years in hospital and general practice posts, she embarked on three years, full-time, specialist training in special care dentistry in Wales. She is a registered specialist in special care dentistry with the General Dental Council

(GDC) since 2017. Having held a consultant in special care dentistry role in Cardiff University Dental Hospital, she returned to Ireland in 2021, and now works as a senior dental surgeon in the HSE in Cork.

SPEAKERS AFTERNOON

Dr Bob Philpott



Bob qualified from University College Cork in 2003 and completed his endodontic training at Eastman Dental Institute in London in 2009, before gaining his Membership in restorative dentistry from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. He has worked in endodontics in Ireland, the UK and Australia. From 2014

to 2022, he divided his time as a senior clinical lecturer/consultant in endodontics at the Edinburgh Dental Institute, and in private practice at Edinburgh Dental Specialists. He was the training programme director for the Doctorate of Clinical Dentistry in Endodontology at the University of Edinburgh. He returned to Cork in 2022 and now works in private practice with Michael Hartnett at The Clermont Clinic in Cork City.

Dr Colm Sugrue



Colm has a practice limited to prosthodontics and implant dentistry in Dublin and sees patients in Tralee one day per month. He is a UCC graduate and worked in general practice in the UK for a few years before completing prosthodontic training at Eastman Dental Hospital,

Rochester, New York, and obtaining a master's degree from the University of Rochester. He has been involved in teaching at Trinity College since 1992 and currently teaches in the doctoral prosthodontics programme there.

Kieran Donaghy



Kieran Donaghy, widely known as 'Star', has been hugely successful as both a footballer and a basketball player. He won footballer of the year, three national leagues, four All-Ireland medals and three all-star awards with the Kerry senior football team. He also won two county championships and a Munster club title with Austin Stacks. As a basketball player with Tralee Warriors, he

won national basketball player of the year, two super leagues, three national cups and two champions trophy medals. A hugely popular figure on and off the court, he is also a coach with the Armagh senior football team.
